DINING FACILITY POLICIES

The Health Department requires shirt and shoes to be worn in the dining facilities at all times.

NORTHWEST KANSAS TECHNICAL COLLEGE DINING PROGRAM

All students living in Student Housing participate in a meal plan. This meal plan offers 17 meals per week in the Cafeteria.

Three meals each day Monday through Friday and Brunch on Saturday and Sunday.

CMCO and NWKTC have designed meal plans that will maximize your choices. A rotation of daily menu selections will be featured in the Cafeteria. Concepts include: The Main Event, Tastefully Healthy Entrees, Smoke House Grill, Green's & Things Garden Salad Bar, Soups On, Subby's Sandwiches & Wraps,

Noodles & More Station,
Sweet Treats, Harvest Grains Bar
And the Hydration Station.

There are also options available for non-resident diners. Please see the food service director to decide on your best option for dining at Northwest Tech.

LOST CARD PROCEDURE

If a meal card is lost, it must be reported immediately to the Admissions Office. A new card will be issued for a replacement charge.

We are sorry but we are not able to allow you to eat in the cafeteria without your meal card or temporary card.

All About Your Meal Card

What is the meal ID card? CMCO uses a computerized photo ID card system. This system uses card readers. When a card is inserted into the read, the data encoded on the card is electronically scanned and sent to the memory unit, which indicates to the cashier whether the card is valid. Your photo also appears on the screen to assure our cashier the proper meal plan owner is presenting the card

How do I use my card? Your meal ID card must be presented at each meal you intend to eat. The cashier will take your card, verify your picture and insert it in a card reader. If the reader indicates that your card has not been accepted previously for that meal, your card will be returned, and you may enter the serving area. Invalid cards will be picked up by the cashier. If your card is signaled invalid, you should check with the cafeteria office immediately. There may be several reasons for this condition. The system also protects you from unauthorized use of your ID card. Since the ID card system prevents unauthorized persons from using the food services you have paid for, ID cards and temporary cards are not transferable for any reason! We must be notified as soon as you discover that your ID card has been lost or stolen.

Why do I have to show my card every time I come to the dining hall? Your ID card identifies you as an owner of a meal contract. It must be shown to the cashier every time you eat a meal. Without the

card, the cashier will not be able to indicate to the memory unit that your card was used at the meal.

I lost my meal ID card. What do I do? Your ID card is valuable and you should treat it like cash or a credit card. If you lose or damage it, you must replace it by reporting it to the Admissions office. After reporting a lost card, you will be given a new ID card. There may be a non-refundable charge for the replacement card. If you lose your meal ID card on the weekend, the loss must be reported to a CMCO manager immediately. A temporary card will then be issued.

Why can't I let my friends use my meal card when I'm gone? I paid for the meals. Board rates are based on actual meals served, not on the cash value of the outstanding meal cards. In other words, we established board rates on the statistical fact that the average student will attend only a certain percentage of meals served. If meal ID cards were transferable, then the basic cost of your card would have been increased to offset the increase in attendance.



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
